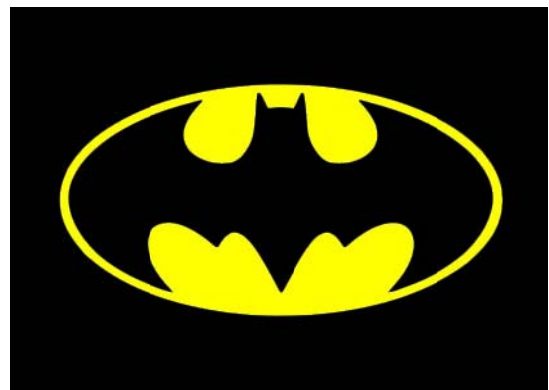
New York is in New York State. New York City has nickname like « The City that never sleep ».

The Second Day in New York City:

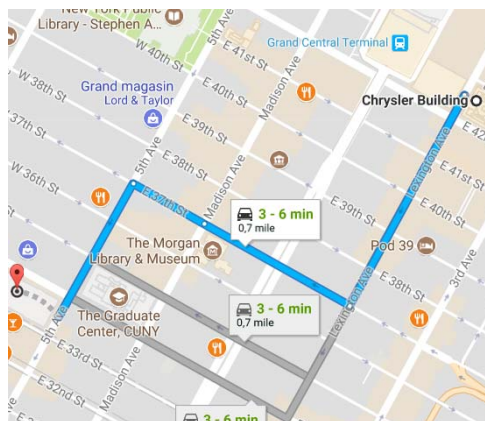

designed in a art deco style.

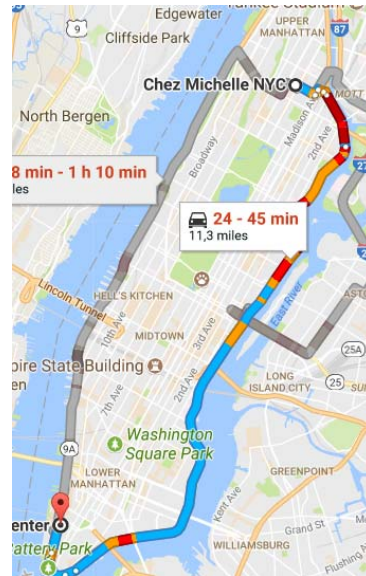

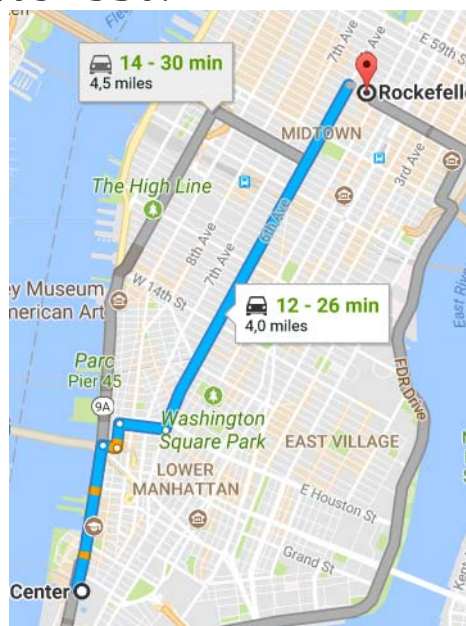


The Third Day in New York City:

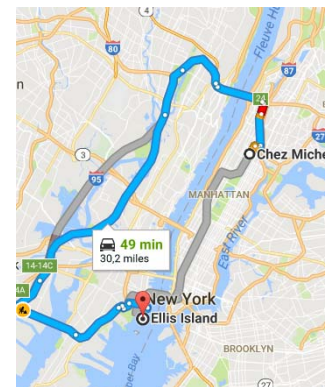

The Last Day in New York City:

For the last day, I have chosen Ellis Island. Ellis Island was an immigration center from 1892 to 1954, More than 12 million immigrants went through this building. The immigrants came from Europe (Poland, Russia Italy), fleeing poverty and the religious persecution. For information, the first person to go through Ellis Island is an Irish, Annie Moore, that was 15 years old. Today, Ellis Island, is the museum of Immigration.
